Educational Awards

Membership

The Division is deficient an Area Director for Area 11, but the past AD and stalwart Toastmasters working as a team are carrying out the duties.

Contests

Planning for Area and Division Contests is progressing, and club contests are underway.

Clubs

One club, Highfields, has surrendered its charter. This was because of a decision made in the previous year.

New Clubs

No new clubs are projected. The emphasis is on retaining and consolidating membership of the many clubs that have fewer than the 20 members required to charter a club.

Successors for Director Roles

The incumbent Area 31 director has agreed to nominate for the Western Division Director role in 2025-26. Area Director successors are yet to materialise.

Other Information/Comments

The current early months of the Toastmasters year are busy and challenging for new area directors. Arranging area conferences and contests, conducting visits to clubs, assisting the division director with club officer training and encouraging clubs in membership retention and recruiting initiatives.
